



ANIMAL WELFARE POLICY

We assume the commitment to putting all our attention and effort to continuously improve the welfare of our animals, and of those who are part of our supply chain. This responsibility is directly related to the culture and values we have as a company, and it is something we must build day by day among all of us. We share our stakeholders' concern about the care, health and welfare of the animals used in food production.

At Adecoagro we strive to provide optimal conditions so that each animal can adapt favorably to its environment. It is important that each animal can be healthy, comfortable, safe and well fed. In this sense, animal welfare is the basis for good production performance in a sustainable manner.

Our production model includes the so-called "5 Freedoms", which are guidelines established by the World Organization for Animal Health. We ensure that our cows live free from hunger and thirst, through easy access to drinking water and a diet that guarantees an adequate level of health and vigor; live free from discomfort, thanks to a suitable environment and comfortable resting areas; live free from pain, injury and disease, through prevention, diagnosis and appropriate treatment; are free to express normal patterns of behavior, with adequate facilities, in the company of animals of their own species and with the same health status; and live free from fear and distress by having the right conditions and a treatment that avoids suffering.

To develop this new paradigm of responsible production and thus achieve optimal conditions, we are committed to the following:

- To disseminate a culture of animal welfare and permanent training for both our personnel and the members of our value chain.
- To prioritize the good treatment of animals. We pay special attention to herding, in order to do it calmly, with short distances, and without actions that may generate stress or pose a threat to our cows.
- To provide housing that maximizes comfort. To provide adequate resting and rumination sites in order to facilitate rest, and that the cows are clean and fresh. And to provide adequate cooling systems to avoid heat stress in times of high temperatures.
- To permanently and frequently clean beds, aisles, and circulation areas.
- To provide adequate feeding, from own production, with balanced diets that favor healthy growth. To provide fresh, clean, accessible, and permanent water.
- To provide continuous veterinary treatment so as to achieve disease prevention and/or adequate care at an early stage.
- To have rodeos where all cows are in the company of animals of the same species, in order to satisfy their gregarious nature.
- To minimize the use of antibiotics.
- Not to use growth hormones.
- To ensure ethical standards for animal transportation.
- To implement ethical standards for animal slaughtering.

In Adecoagro we work to consolidate our sustainable production system, and the compliance with this policy is vital to achieve this objective.
